GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

A student must complete each course with a passing score of at least 80% in order to graduate from the Program.

Responsibility: Students, Faculty, Program Director Standard: Administration

To be eligible for graduation the student must:

Complete each course with a minimum score of 80%.

Settle all financial obligations with the Program.

Return all property belonging to the Program or Regional West (name badges, radiation monitoring badge, etc.).

Complete the required number of days of attendance. A second year student exceeding the allowable amount of time off will make up the time at the end of the school term prior to receiving their diploma. If makeup time is necessary in order for the student to receive his/her degree, this will be straight time (one day of clinical education for each day to be made up).

Any student failing to complete the graduation requirements will not receive his or her signed diploma until all the graduation requirements are met.
