In accordance with the Public Law 102-26, the Higher Education Technical Amendments of 1991, students entering Regional West Medical Center School of Radiologic Technology shall be informed of the graduation rate for students in the Program.

The graduation rate shall be determined by using the number entering the Program compared to those graduating from Regional West Medical Center School of Radiologic Technology.

When calculating the total number of students enrolled in the program, the program need not consider students who attrite due to nonacademic reasons. Some reasons could include:

- 1. financial,
- 2. medical/mental health,
- 3. family reasons
- 4. military deployment
- 5. change in major/course of study
