RADIATION PROTECTION WHEN USING DEPARTMENT RADIOGRAPHIC EQUIPMENT AS AN ENERGIZED LABORATORY

Radiologic technology students shall be supervised when using radiation producing equipment in laboratory procedures.

Responsibility: Students, Faculty, Clinical staff

Standard: Radiation Protection

Radiologic technology students shall perform procedures that require the production of ionizing radiation when using department radiographic equipment in energized laboratory situations only under the supervision of a qualified radiographer who is readily available.

A student who energizes radiation producing equipment without adequate supervision is subject to Corrective Action Policy.

During any energized laboratory procedure, radiation monitoring badges shall be worn by students.
