Responsibility: Students, Program Officials Standard: Environment

The sale of tobacco and related materials on hospital premises is prohibited. Violations will be handled in accordance with Corrective Action Policy.

This policy includes all students anywhere within Regional West Health Services owned or leased property.

Smoking, vaping, or tobacco products are not allowed anywhere at any off-campus clinical education facility. This includes all clinical education facility property, grounds, buildings, parking lots and roadways.
